CTE - pathways that integrate hands-on learning and cutting-edge technology to prepare students with academic, technical, and employability skills; no entrance criteria

GT - a program serving formally identified gifted/talented students in a specific area such as general intellectual ability, reading, math, creativity, leadership, and the performing arts

Alternative - a program designed to meet students' needs that cannot be addressed in a traditional classroom setting; FCPS administrators handle the placement process
