- We used the new bus for the first time for tutoring transportation last week and today. The Alview students in particular felt very special to ride the bus for the first time.
- Several of us met with the Cook Institute last week to discuss their offerings for mental health and parenting support for families. They have classes as well as AI-generated and in-person counseling for parents and staff. We will entertain a proposal at our next meeting.
- After meeting with Isom Advisors during Spring Break, they will be attending our next meeting along with Schoolworks. Together they will be presenting information on the logistics of a bond measure coupled with state funding.
- The Teaching Fellows Spring Break program only averaged about 20 students per day even though 38 were registered.

- Yesterday, we had our 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter awards assembly at Dairyland. Basketball awards and A.R. achievement certificates were presented as well as Constitution Test achievement and a blue ticket drawing.
- Kevin Bracy was at both campuses today with an inspiring message for students to put forth 100% effort on testing.
- Testing actually starts Thursday for 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Science; next week is grades 4-6, 7-8 will test the week of the 27<sup>th</sup> and we'll conclude with Alview the first week in May.
- Our band competed in the Ohlone College festival on Friday and ended the day at Great America. They won "excellence in performance" and an "outstanding musicianship" award for our clarinets. As a reminder, the chicken dinner is Saturday evening from 4:30 to 6:30.

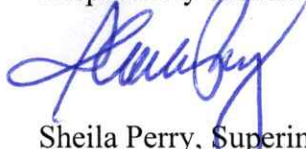
