2026 Summer Enrichment Courses

July 6th- 30th 2026

Monday-Thursday each week

Kindergarten Camp! (All morning, 8:30-11:30)

Grade: 5K

This course is for children entering the 5-year-old Kindergarten class in the Fall of 2026. Children will learn about the world around them through play, literature, songs, crafts, and hands-on activities.

1st Grade Readiness (All morning, 8:30-11:30)

Grade: 1

This course is for children entering 1st grade in the fall of 2026. Let's get ready for First Grade! We will practice reading, writing, solving problems, playing games, and experimenting—all while having fun learning.

2nd Grade Readiness “Dino Adventures” (90 mins) (2 sections)

Grade: 2

Imagination Station (90 mins)

Grades: 2-3

Together, we will share our work with peers and the whole class to develop strong expressive language skills. Students will be invited to ask each other questions, share adventurous stories, problem-solve social scenarios, and more!

Board Games Bonanza (90 mins)

Grades 2-3
