We hope you understand that - as was said through the audition process, we want to find a place where each student can **thrive**. Every single student is important to us, and we want to make sure you end up in the ensemble that will challenge you to reach your potential without overwhelming you. For the second year in a row – we were unable to cast every student in a show choir this year.

If you end up being pleased by your placement, please keep these things in mind:

- ***Be Humble.***
 - Just because you've reached your goal doesn't mean that you can become complacent and sit back. The road to 2027 starts now, and every choice you make has either a positive, or negative repercussion that can determine our success both on and off the stage.
 - Your placement is a privilege. Others wanted your place, and rosters can easily be changed - remember that. Remember while your words matter- your actions matter as well.
- ***Be excited.***
 - We hope you are thrilled about the prospect of next year! However, your excitement may bring heartache to others. Be careful how, where and with whom you express your joy.
 - Congrats! You are part of a show choir program that has a long and rich tradition. You are both an inheritor and torchbearer! Be ready to work hard and keep a tradition alive. Allow yourself to embrace being comfortable with being uncomfortable. The sky is the limit, and when we believe in growth and hard work, we have the potential for a “perfect” year.

 - Come in with a strong desire to showcase your talents! Especially if you're a current or incoming 9th grader, remember that you're YOUNG! There is so much growth ahead of you in nearly every aspect of your life-including choir!

If you end up not being cast in a Show Choir *this year*

- ***Be strong.***
 - Your value to society is not determined by being in Show Choir at South. We wanted to cast all – but were unable to do so **this year**. We strongly encourage you to reach out to Mr. Gruttemeyer/Ramirez for feedback, so you know what you can focus on in the year ahead before your next audition. We will be reaching out to those not cast about other opportunities to be a part of the show choir program this year. It might sting – but we are still here for you and want you to be engaged in our program. We ask for a bit of patience before we announce these plans!
