



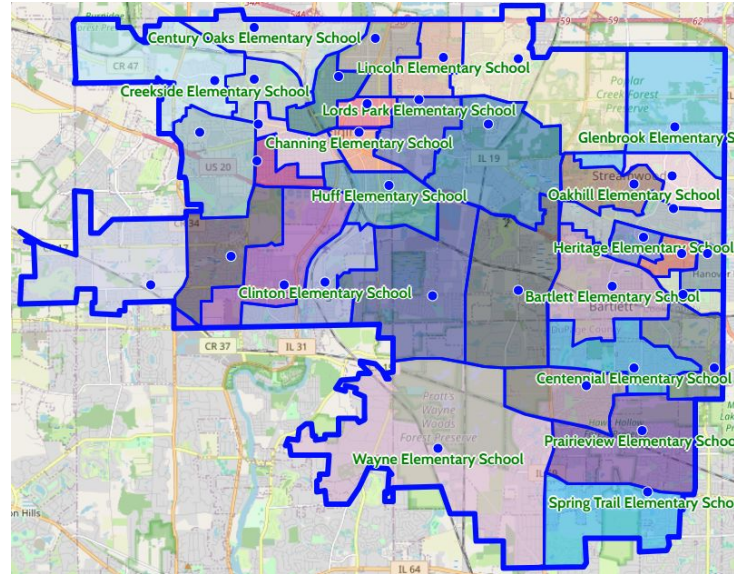

# Transportation Readiness



## THREE-TIER Transportation Framework

Shift the bell times for elementary and middle schools 5 minutes later.

 ES	7:55 - 2:15	7:45 - 2:20
 MS	9:05 - 3:41	8:55 - 3:46



# Transportation Readiness



- **Routes Finalized:** All routes are nearing completion with final validation focused on safe stop locations, accurate timing, and balanced ride times.
- **Proactive Family Communication:** Route information will be shared with families in advance, with clear details on bus stops, times, and expectations, followed by updates as needed. Routing information will be available in August.
- **Safety-First Approach:** Route design prioritizes student safety, including stop placement, reduced road crossings where possible, and ongoing driver training and monitoring.
- **Operational Efficiency:** Routes are optimized to improve on-time performance, reduce excess mileage, and align with school schedules and tiered service.
- **Strong Start Preparedness:** Systems, staffing, and communication plans are in place to ensure a smooth, safe, and efficient start to the 2026–2027 school year.
