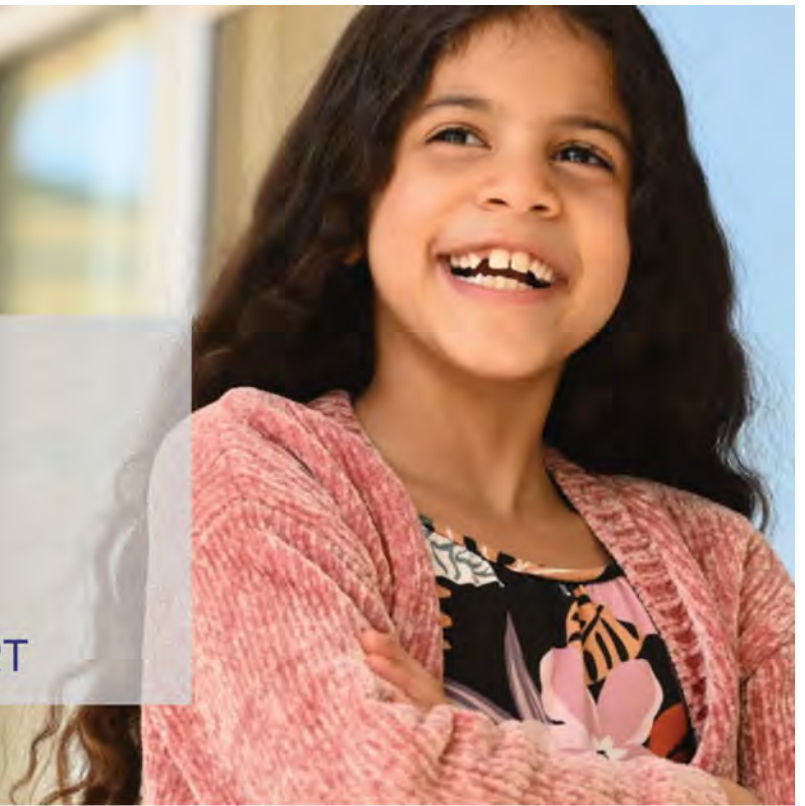

# FALL 2026 KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

## FEBRUARY 2 - MAY 15

Register online at [www.fargo.k12.nd.us/registration](http://www.fargo.k12.nd.us/registration)

Children must be age 5 by July 31, 2026 to attend school in the fall.

*Kindergarten Registration is a three-step process:*

### STEP 1: PRE-REGISTER ONLINE

Complete the pre-registration form at [www.fargo.k12.nd.us/registration](http://www.fargo.k12.nd.us/registration).

After office staff review and approve your pre-registration, a confirmation email with instructions to create the PowerSchool account will be sent.

### STEP 2: POWERSCHOOL REGISTRATION FORMS

Create a Parent PowerSchool Account and complete the registration forms.

### STEP 3: SUBMIT REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

Upload or bring the following documents to your child's school:

- Child's Certified Birth Certificate
- Parent Identity (driver's license)
- Child's Immunization Record (with 5-year shots)
- Proof of Address (lease/mortgage statement or two documents that include parent/guardian name and current address, such as a utility bill and paystub)



For assistance, please contact your child's school to schedule an appointment to complete in-person.



A second round of registration will reopen in July with a different process.

# School is out! Now what?

## Look to private therapy for speech, occupational, and physical therapy.

### 1 When can my child be seen?

School: During the school year, August-May and ESY

Private: Anytime throughout the year



### 2 How much does each session cost?

School: Free to families

Private: Each session is run through your insurance.

### 3 Where can services take place?

School: Classroom or special ed room

Private: Daycare, home, clinic, private school, after school program

### 4 How many children are seen together in a session?

School: small group setting or 1:1 ratio

Private: 1:1 ratio

### 5 What are my child's goals?

School: Focuses on educational impact and academic concerns

Private: More freedom to tackle goals outside of academics.

### 6 Can we do both private and school based therapy at the same time?

YES, having therapy in both settings will help achieve your child's goals much quicker
