Then students will be progress monitored based on their level (red, yellow, green) to make sure that they are approaching grade level. Utilizing iReady to determine what students need additional support on for reading and math. Differentiated small group lesson plans. PreK uses their teaching strategies goal data and child report to determine students who are not yet proficient, they can reteach the specific skills. Our Student Services team is also looking at behavior reports to see if supplemental interventions are needed or intensive interventions. Giving support to the teachers and students. ● D4.02 - resources allocated - \$6, 650 used for extended day tutoring in grades 3rd-5th grade to help students with disabilities. This year our goal is to have 37 passed EOGs from SWD. Currently projected to have 41 pass. Want to maintain a C, and not drop down to a D, and exit TSI status.
