Re.: 2026-2027 School Year Calendar

On Monday, April 13, the Centreville Public Schools Board of Education approved the 2026-2027 school year calendar, which is enclosed. There are significant changes we want to bring to your attention...


- **First Day of School.** The first official day of school for students is on **Tuesday, August 18**. It is a half-day.
- **Extended Breaks/No Early Release.** To ensure teachers are provided the state-required professional development and to strengthen collaboration in support of student success, this year's calendar includes one full day, scheduled either before or after breaks, when students will not attend school. Teachers are required to report on these days. Please note that there are **no early release days next year**. There are, however, still several half-days in the calendar.
- **Spring Break.** State law requires that Spring Break be scheduled at the county level. Typically, Spring Break is scheduled multiple years in advance. Families can access the dates for future Spring Breaks by visiting the St. Joseph County Intermediate School District website. Next year, Spring Break begins on Friday, March 26. Students return to school on Tuesday, April 6. Staff returns on Monday, April 5, for professional development.
- **Last Day of School.** Thursday, May 27, and Friday, May 28, are half-days, with the last day of school being May 28.

We believe that the calendar for the next school year provides many benefits to all stakeholders. It meets the goals of our Strategic Plan, establishes a better pathway for professional development, and is more convenient for students and families by removing early release days and extending scheduled breaks.

Notice on the Last Day of this School Year

Due to weather and an unexpected power outage, the district had to close beyond the allowable number of closure days. The district has been in communication with the Michigan Department of Education and has been approved for a waiver. The last day of school will remain as scheduled on Friday, May 29, a half-day for students.
