Looking ahead to our final round of EOC testing next week, we will continue to follow adjusted schedules on testing days to support a focused environment. Non-testers will follow these start times:

**April 28–29 (Algebra I & Geometry):** 2-hour delay, classes begin at 10:15 a.m.

**April 30 (Make-up testing):** Regular start time of 8:00 a.m. for all students

Reminder, students taking exams should come prepared with a fully charged school-issued Chromebook, as devices and chargers will not be available. **As a reminder, cell phones, smart watches, and other electronics are not permitted in testing rooms and should be secured in lockers beforehand.**

If you didn't make it tonight, no worries, you can catch it tomorrow night at the same start time.
