GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students need 130 credits for graduation. This includes the successful completion of:

English (20 credits)

(English I, English II, English II, English IV)

Math (15 credits)

Physical Education and Health (20 credits)

Natural and Physical Science (15 Credits)

(Biology, Chemistry, Physics)

History (15 credits)

(World History, US History I, US History II)

World Language (5 credits)

Personal Finance/Economics (2.5 credits)

Fine or Performing Arts (5 credits)

(Art or Music)

Practical Arts (5 credits)

(Business/Technology, Engineering)

College and Career Readiness (5 credits)

Course Level Options

College Prep (CP): For students meeting grade-level standards, preparing for college and careers.

Honors: For high-achieving students, offering more rigorous and challenging coursework.

**** Below not offered to 9th Grade Students**

Dual Enrollment: College-level courses taken during high school, earning both high school and college credit.

Advanced Placement (AP): College-level coursework designed for students ready to take on more challenging material and earn potential college credit.

Scheduling Honors Classes

If you are interested in an honors course for 9th grade, please request it.

Eligibility will be determined based on the guidelines outlined in the [Program of Studies](#)

After 9th grade, you must have a 90 or above in a College Prep course to move up to Honors the following year

What If I Am In An Academy?

All Academy students will take English I, World History, Algebra I (or Geometry), Physical Education I, Physics, and a World Language

What if I have an IEP?

Students with IEPs **do not** need to request core classes in which they receive support (English, Math, Science, History)

Counselors will input the correct core classes based on the outcome of the IEP annual review

Students should request their electives and PE/Health

If students have questions about their placement, they should contact their case manager

Scheduling Process

- 1) Talk with your parents/guardians about your course selections
- 2) Enter course selections into Genesis Parent Portal by **May 8th.**
- 3) High School counselors will meet individually with students to review requests
