## AP Exam Information

AP Exams are scheduled for May 4 – May 15, 2026. See the attached AP Exam testing calendar for specific dates, times, and locations.

### **Arrival – \*\*\*\*Report to the gym concession stand area for check-in!\*\*\*\***

You are required to arrive no later than 30 minutes prior to your exam. If you are taking an 8:00 AM exam, you should **arrive no later than 7:30 AM** for the morning administration. If you are taking a 12:00 noon exam, you should **arrive no later than 11:30 AM** for the afternoon administration. Students may not be dismissed until an exam has officially ended; do not ask to leave early if you finish before the end of the exam. If you play a sport or have a job, it is your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP Exam obligation, and arrangements should be made accordingly. Exams start early and may end after 3:15, so arrangements for bus riders should be made accordingly.

### **You should bring the following items to the exam room:**

- **A government-issued or school-issued photo ID.** You must provide identification at the time of sign-in to be admitted to the testing room.
- Several sharpened **No. 2 pencils** (with erasers) for completing multiple-choice answer sheets.
- **Pens with black or dark blue ink** for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams.
- Up to two calculators with the necessary capabilities if you are taking an AP Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Macroeconomics, Physics, or Statistics Exam. (Visit [www.collegeboard.org/ap/calculators](http://www.collegeboard.org/ap/calculators) to learn more about the calculator policy for each of these exams, and for a list of authorized calculators.) Also, see attached AP-Approved Graphing Calculator handout.
- A ruler or straightedge only if you are taking an AP Physics Exam. (Protractors are not allowed.)
- An analog watch, nothing that has Bluetooth ability (in case your exam room does not have a clock that you can see easily).
- It is advisable to bring a sweater/hoodie in case the room temperature is below your comfort level.
- If taking an online exam as noted on the testing schedule attached, you **MUST BRING YOUR CHROMEBOOK AND CHARGER.** Exams cannot be taken on a personal device.

### **You should not bring the following to the exam room:**

- **Leave your cell phones and smart watches at home or in your car! If you are found with a cell phone or smart watch during the AP Exam, your test will be invalidated, and school disciplinary action will be taken. UGHS is not responsible for housing them during testing.**
- Electronic devices: phones, smart watches, Meta glasses, or any wearable technology; laptops; portable listening or recording devices (e.g., MP3 players, iPods); cameras or other photographic equipment; any internet-capable device; and all other electronic or communication devices.

Unapproved aids: Books, compasses, mechanical pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters\*, notes or colored pencils\*

- Rulers, straightedges, and protractors\*
- Scratch paper; notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets
- Chromebook\* or calculators\*
- Reference guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions
- Watches that beep or have an alarm
- Clothing with subject-related information
- Food or drink
- **Rule of thumb** – It is best to leave all things in your car or locker except for the items listed in the “Items you should bring to testing” section.
