Today is a **D** day!



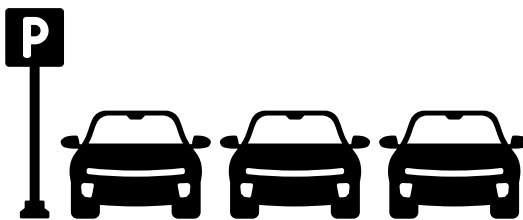

-To clarify student parking locations:

Student Parking (All Student Drivers)

- The Turf Field lot across Girdle Road is the primary parking lot for all student drivers.

Overflow Parking

- When the Turf Field lot is full, students should park in the front section of the Middle School parking lot.

Additional Parking (Only if Both Lots Are Full)

- If both the Turf Field lot and the Middle School lot are full, students may park in front of the High School along Girdle Road only. *The front row is for staff and visitors only.*

Students may not park in any staff-designated parking areas at any time during the school day.

ALL STUDENTS MUST HAVE A PARKING PERMIT!

Beginning immediately, vehicles parked in staff-designated areas may be ticketed, towed at the owner's expense, may result in loss of school parking privileges, and/or may lead to disciplinary action.
