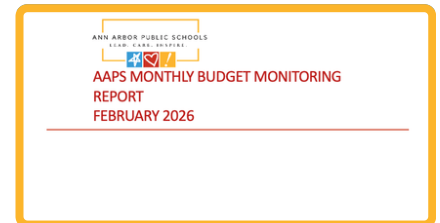
National School Library Month: AAPS Library Services
