- ☐ 1 **Supply case** - zippered with three holes (**no boxes**)
 - ☐ 4 Packs of #2 pencils, pre-sharpened
 - ☐ 1 Pack of **colored pencils** (12 pack)
 - ☐ 5 Ultra fine point black **Sharpies**
 - ☐ 1 Large block **eraser**
 - ☐ 1 Hand-held manual pencil **sharpener**
 - ☐ 2 Packs of 2 x 1.5 **Post-It Notes**
- ☐ 1 Three-ring **binder** (2 inches) *** **No Trapper Keepers, binders that zipper, binders with straps** ***
- ☐ 8 **folders with 2 pockets** poly-vinyl and 3 holes (**NO metal brads** or accordion folders). Do NOT label subjects yet.
- ☐ 3 **Composition** marble notebooks (Reading/English/Social Studies). Note: Not a spiral.

- ☐ 1 Packs of **index cards** (4x6, lined, 100 per pack)
