Contact the 6th grade guidance counselor, [Mr. Mullen](#), if you need assistance with school supplies.

- ☐ 1 **Supply case** zippered with three holes (no boxes)
 - ☐ 2-3 Boxes of **pencils** with at least 4 in supply case (Remaining pencils at home. Replenish as needed.)
 - ☐ 1 Hand-held manual pencil **sharpener**
 - ☐ 1 Large block **eraser**
 - ☐ **Highlighters** (at least two different colors)
 - ☐ 3 Sharpies (2 ultra fine point black and 1 standard fine point)
 - ☐ At least 1 **glue stick**
 - ☐ 1 Pack of **colored pencils** (12 colors)
- ☐ 1 Three-Ring **binder** (Recommended size is 2 inches that will fit folders)
- ☐ 6 **Folders** (Three-hole punched for binder. One for each core class and one extra for special area course.)
- ☐ 2 **Composition** marble notebooks (Reading and English). Note: This is NOT a spiral.
- ☐ 1 Pack of three-hole punched lined loose-leaf **paper** (100 Sheets with 10-20 in binder. Remaining sheets for home.)
- ☐ At least 1 Pack of **index cards** (3x5, white, 100 per pack)
- ☐ 1 Pair of wired **headphones** that connect to laptop.
- ☐ *Optional:* **mouse** if student prefers using external device rather than track pad

If enrolled in *Math 6, Math 6 Plus, Math 7, or Pre-Algebra*

- ☐ TI-15 or TI-30 **calculator**

If enrolled in *Algebra I*

- ☐ TI-84 **calculator** or higher
- ☐ **Graph paper** notebook

Please give to homebase teacher on first day:

- ☐ 2 Large boxes of **tissues**
- ☐ 1 Container of sanitizing **wipes**

Notes & Reminders:

- ☐ Keep supply list receipts as certain supplies could be adjusted depending on teacher and courses students are enrolled in.
- ☐ Bring a snack for morning break each day.
- ☐ All supplies, reusable water bottles, lunch boxes, and personal items should be labeled with student name.
