Course Level Options

College Prep (CP): For students meeting grade-level standards, preparing for college and careers.

Honors: For high-achieving students, offering more rigorous and challenging coursework.

Dual Enrollment: College-level courses taken during high school, earning both high school and college credit.

Advanced Placement (AP): College-level coursework designed for students ready to take on more challenging material and earn potential college credit.

Scheduling Honors/AP Classes

Any student who wishes to move from a College Prep to Honors course, or an Honors course to an Advanced Placement course, will have to demonstrate success by having a final average of a 90 or above.

If you do not have a final grade yet, you can still request Honors/AP courses for next year. Student grades will be reviewed at the end of the year for placement.

What if I have an IEP?

Students with IEPs **do not** need to request core classes in which they receive support (English, Math, Science, History)

Counselors will input the correct core classes based on the outcome of the IEP annual review

Students should request their electives and PE/Health

If students have questions about their placement, they should contact their case manager

Graduation Requirements

Students need 130 credits for graduation

This includes the successful completion of:

- 4 courses in English

- 3 courses in Math

- 4 courses in Physical Education and Health

- 3 courses in Natural and Physical Science

- 3 courses in History (World, US I, US II)

- 1 course in a World Language

- Personal Finance/Economics course

- 1 Fine or Performing Arts course (Art, Music)

- 1 Practical Art course (Business/Technology)

- College and Career Readiness course (Senior Year)

Ocean County College: Early Release For Seniors

Seniors can have early release to take courses online or at OCC if you have met your graduation requirements and have a GPA of 85 or greater

You must meet the criteria for the OCC Early College Program

You can take one or two courses per semester

You are responsible for your own transportation to OCC

You are responsible for the cost of the courses

Talk to your school counselor if interested

Keep in mind that credits may or may not transfer to some colleges/universities

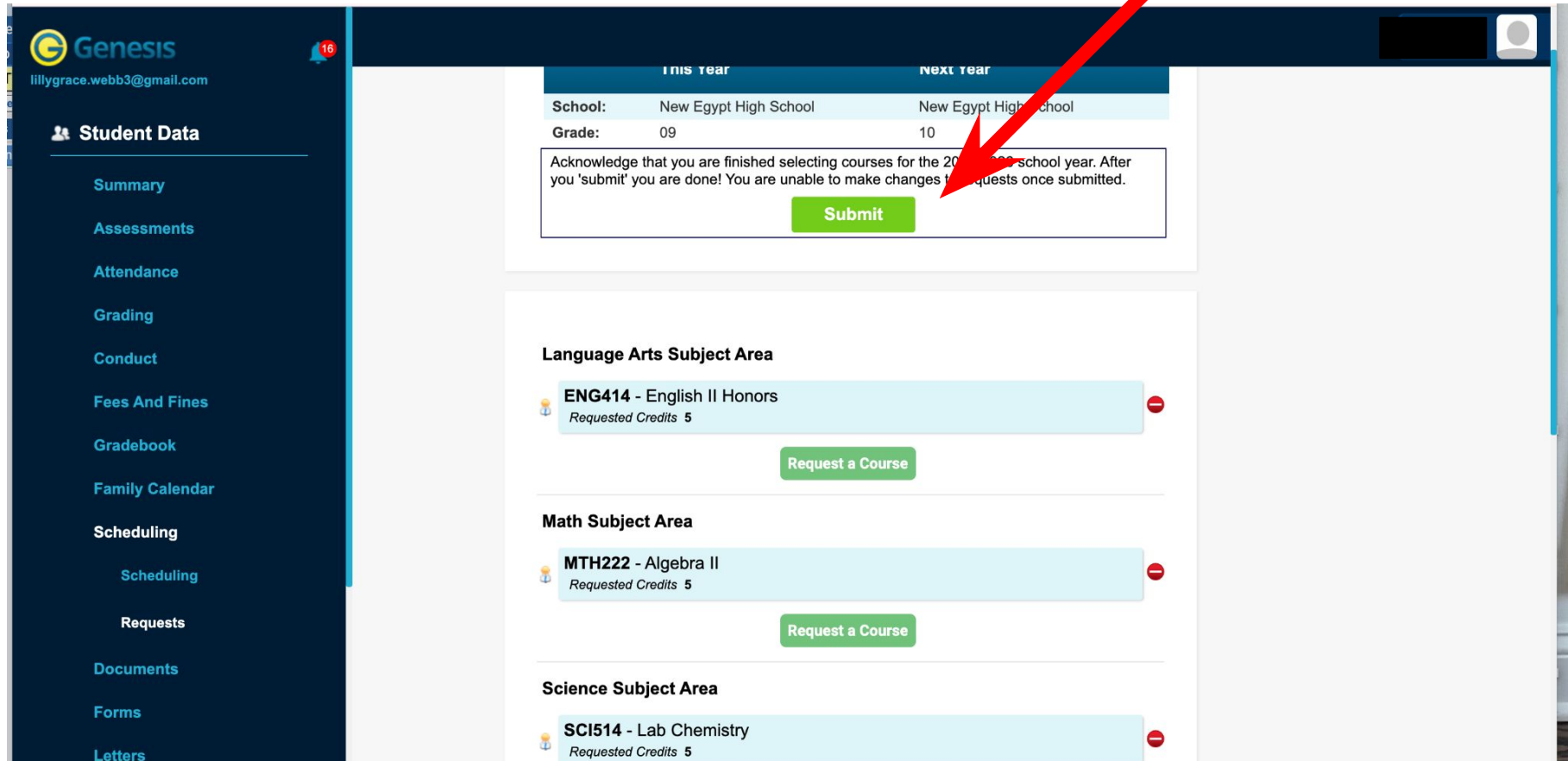
