COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

Fundraising	Work with community restaurants to organize DNO (dinner night out) as well as other fundraising events throughout the year
Publicity	Update social media and inform followers of H&S events
Spring Fest	Organize and work with volunteers to ensure that the Spring Festival runs well.
Running Club	Organize and assist Coach Talac and Mr. Liska with running club. Help with check-in, organizing parent volunteers and safety.
Adult Social	Coordinate and oversee budget, assist volunteers for the Adult Social Fundraiser, help plan and execute event.
Nominations	Coordinate with the executive team to fill open committee roles as needed.
VIP Bowling	Assist committee chair with checking in guests as needed the day of the event.

Fall Fundraiser	Help coordinate and execute the fall fundraiser.
Community Liaison	Coordinate the vision/hearing screening and assist on the day of with escorting children to the testing area. Organize school supply kits. Update Directory Spot.
Room Parent	Coordinate 3 classroom parties, Adult Social art piece, and Springfest basket. Lead other parent helpers in planning crafts and activities.
Room Parent Helper	Assist room parents with classroom parties, Adult Social art piece and Springfest basket
SFCP	Support different family events (STEAM night, multicultural night, walk to school day, etc.)
Family Connections	Help collect donations for Ellsworth families in need, spend 30 minutes collecting money outside of Jewel for Thanksgiving meals, coordinate with school social worker to help families in need throughout the year
LC (Learning Commons)	Reshelving books, organizing STEM pieces, and Book Fair.
Hospitality	Provide staff with snacks during parent-teacher conferences, teacher appreciation week, winter appreciation lunch and other staff appreciation days. Perfect for working families!
