This year's theme is Showstoppers - singers dancers musicians - show us your talents - there are 3 rehearsals being held after school:

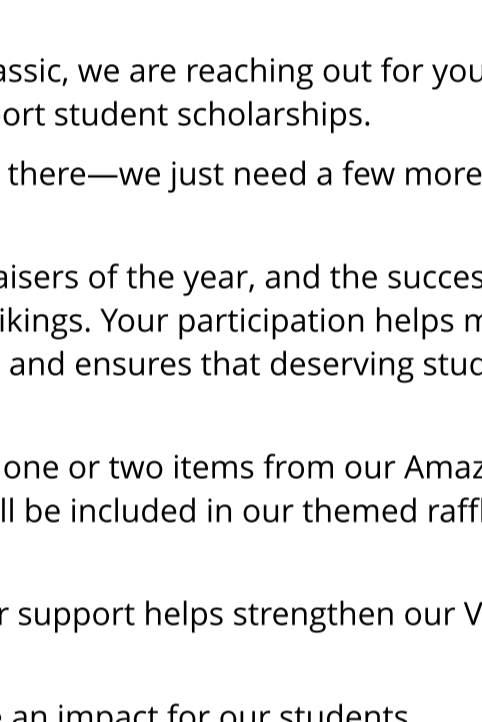
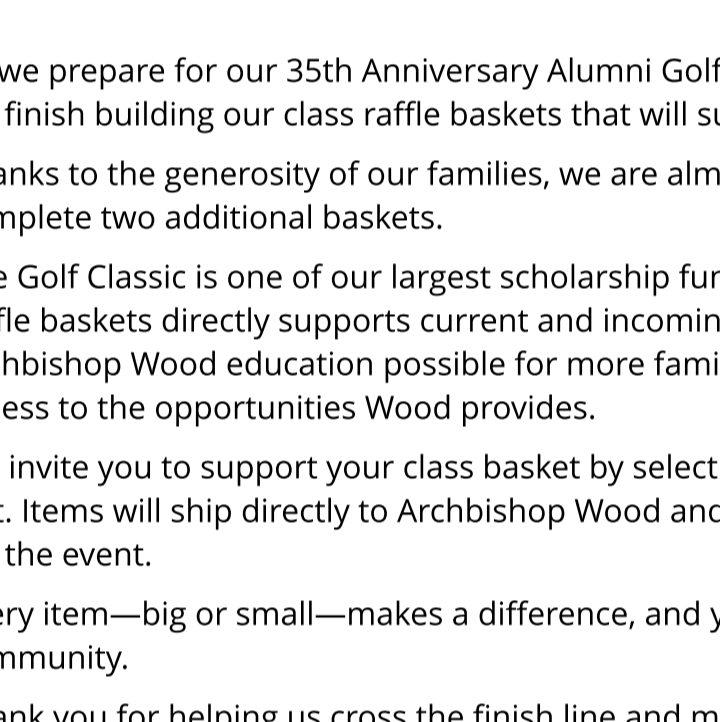

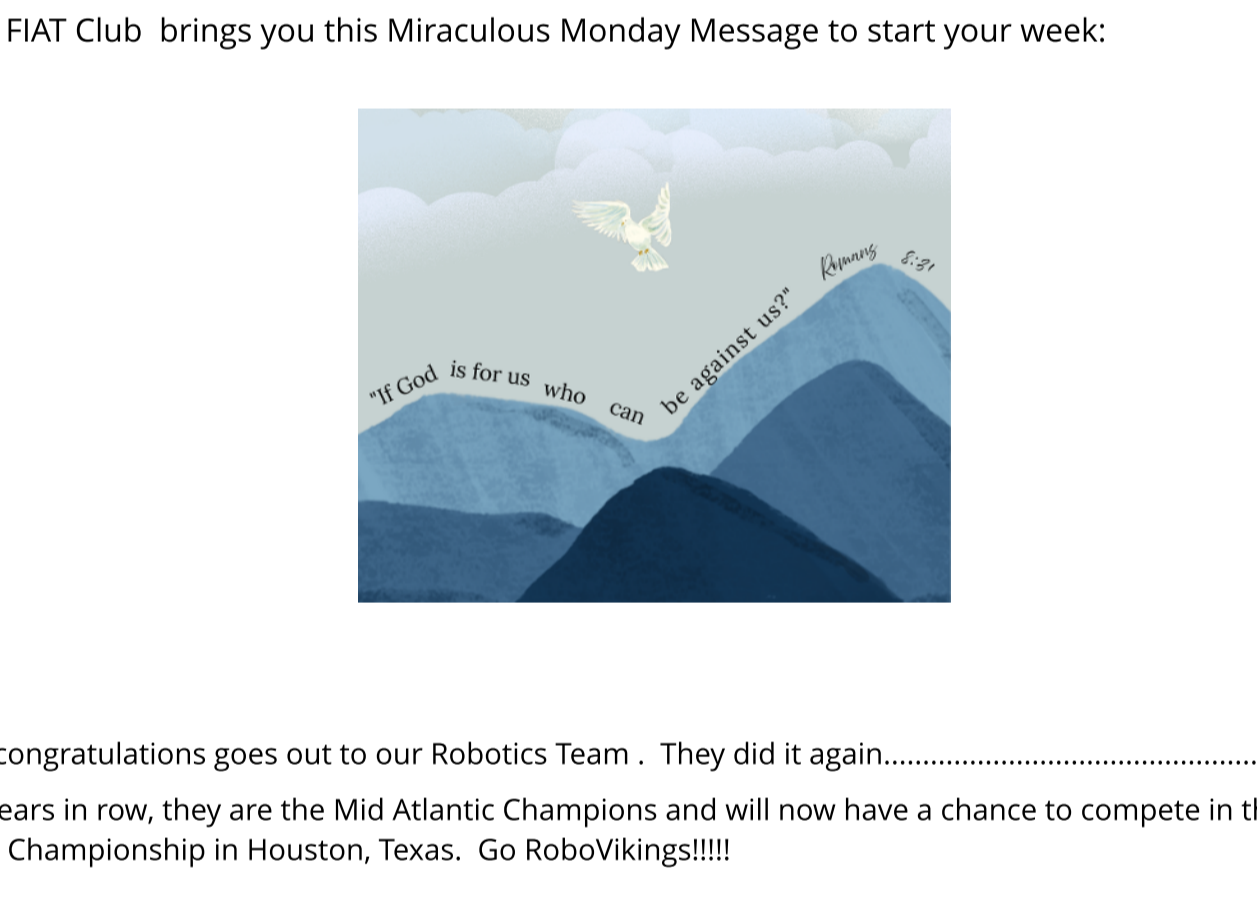


The Archbishop Wood baseball program recently hosted its 1st Annual Autism Acceptance Game on Apr. 11 versus Upper Merionland.
