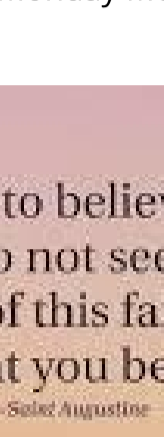

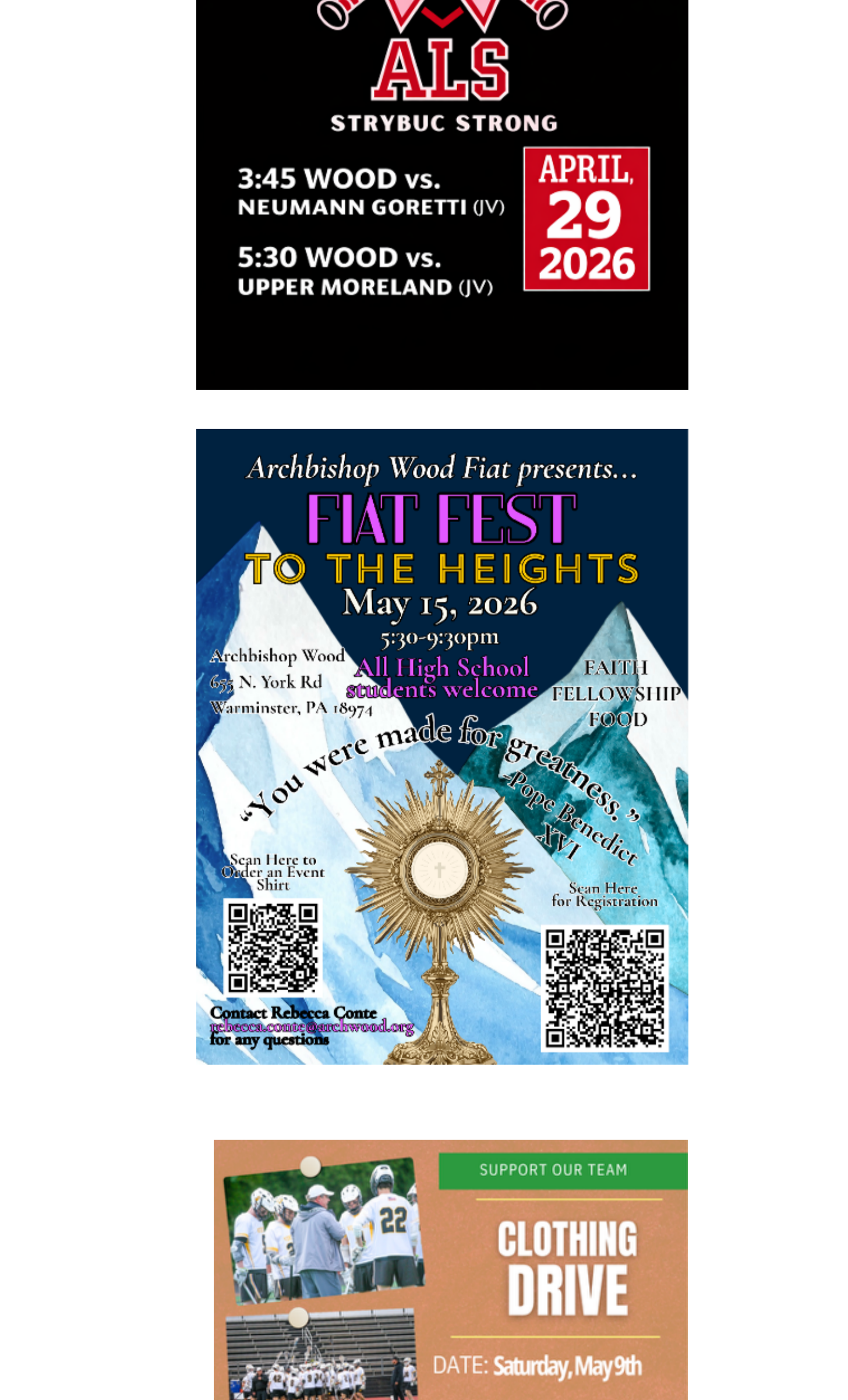


The Archbishop Wood community was proud to be out in full support of Nativity of Our Lord's Walk-a-Thon!

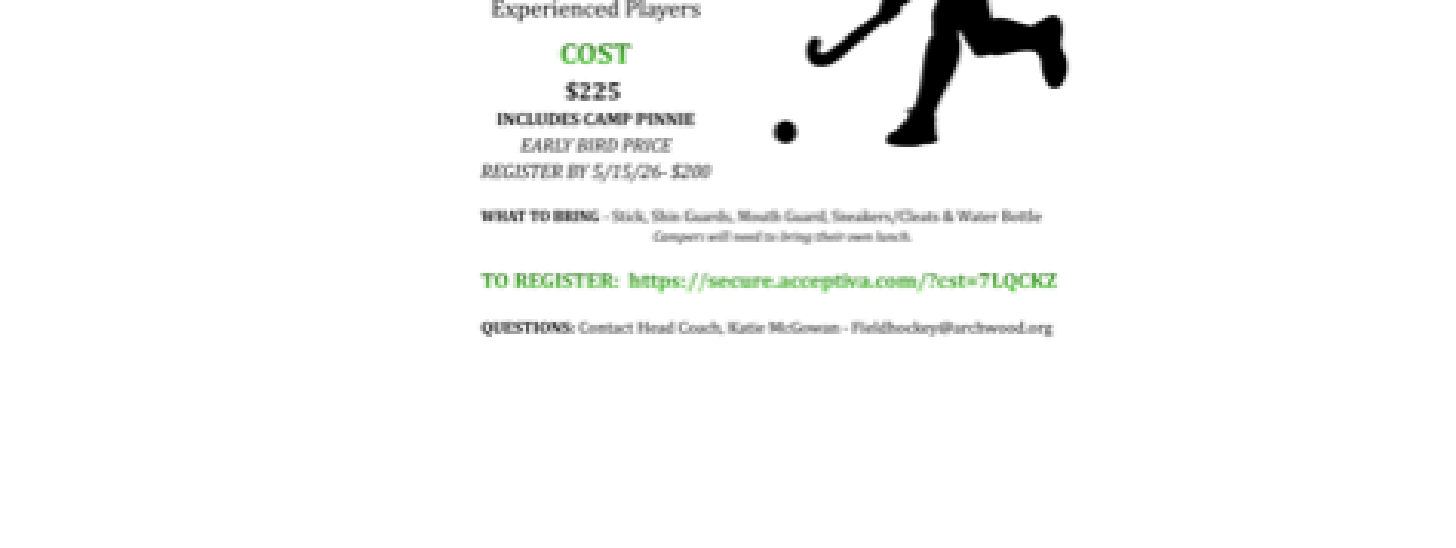
