Online Registration & Payment Option

We use RegWerks for our online registration and payment option. There are no fees for paying online. Below is how to access the system:

1. Go to: www.maccray.k12.mn.us/communityed
2. Click on “**Register for programs here!**”
3. **Log in to the Web Store.** You will need to set up an account initially to access the system. After that, just log in!
 - Setting up an account – one parent or guardian creates a family account and adds all family members.
 - Registrations are recorded and tracked based on the Account Holder’s email address. Please use one account for all family members.
4. From there, you will be able to see the classes offered for the current season.
 - They are separated by **Early Childhood, Youth, and Adult**. Click on the category that fits what you are looking for.
5. **Fill out the required information and add to the Shopping Cart.** When done, click on your Shopping Cart to pay.

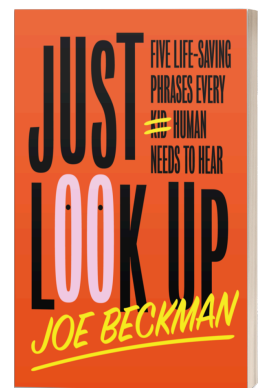


- **Robotics Session:** Build and code your **robot** to challenge other teams to different obstacles courses and missions. We have five different robots this summer.
