Research shows that regular school attendance is one of the most important factors in student achievement. Every missed day is a lost opportunity for your child to learn.

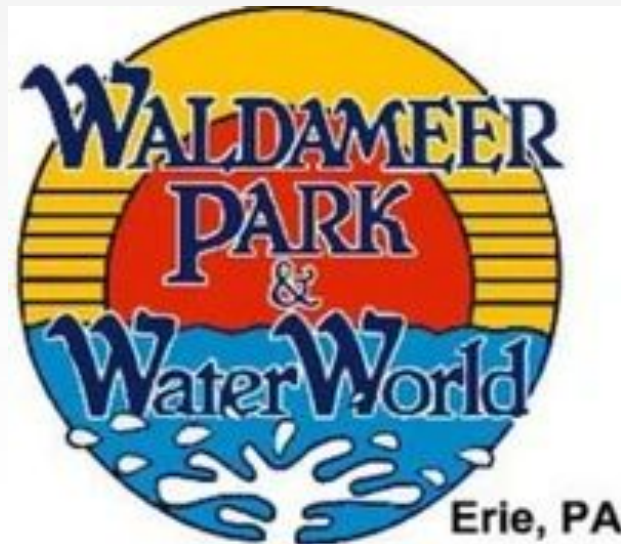

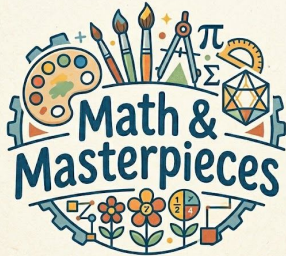


# Oakview Summer Opportunities

Open to students entering grades 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5

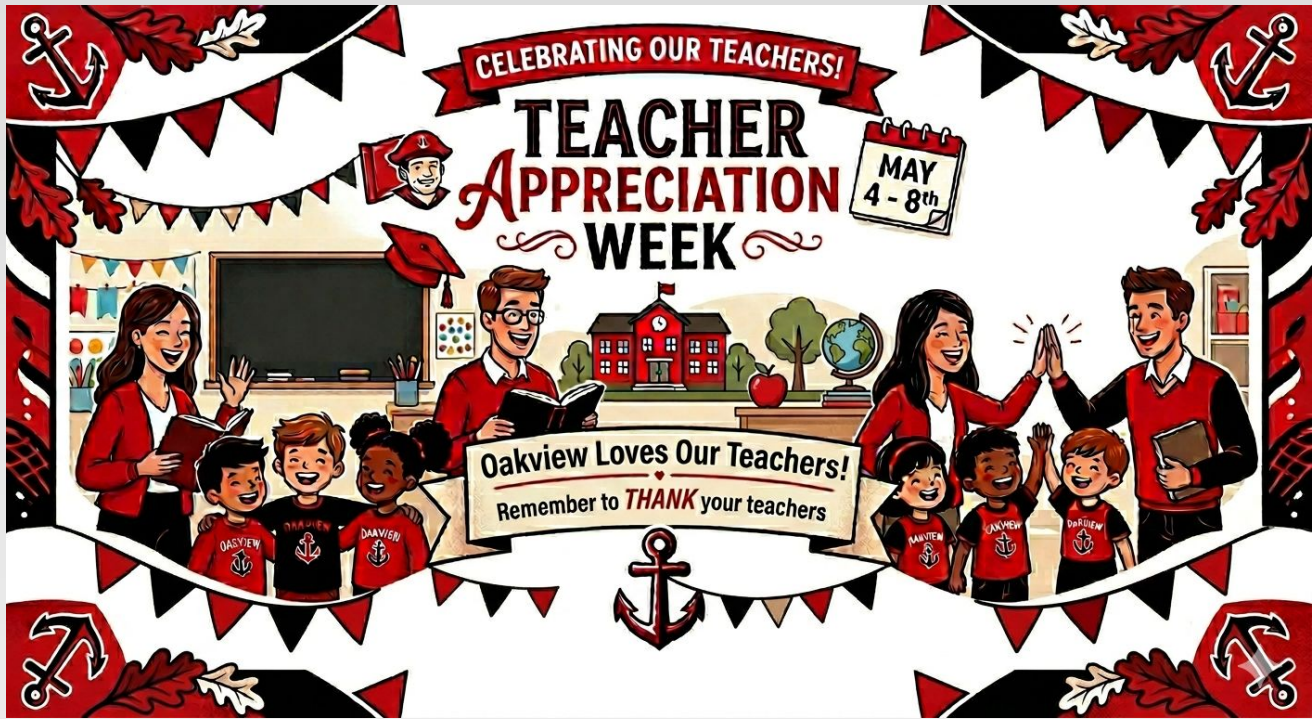
