### **Purpose**

The Board considers academic honesty to be the foundation of its educational program and a fundamental expectation in course work completed by students. Cheating and plagiarism compromise the educational integrity of the district's educational program. The faculty and administration of the district believe that enforcing rules against student cheating and academic dishonesty will enhance the validity of the educational program for every student.

### **Guidelines**

All work submitted as a part of the course requirements of the district must be the original work of the student.

Violations of this policy shall be cumulative from grade 6 through grade 8 and from grade 9 through grade 12. Disciplinary referrals for violations of this policy shall be maintained in the student's disciplinary file.

This policy shall be disseminated in student handbooks and posted in all classrooms and on the district's website.

### **Delegation of Responsibility**

The Superintendent or designee shall develop administrative regulations to implement this policy.

Teachers shall be required to review this policy and administrative regulations with students.

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
