

## **Subject: Uniform Updates for 2026–2027**

Dear TSCS Families,

We're writing to share some important updates to our uniform program ahead of the 2026–2027 school year. We've simplified our uniform options and moved to a new vendor, and we want to make sure every family has a clear picture of what's changing, what's staying the same, and what you can hold onto a little longer.

We've tried to think through as many details as possible in advance, and we've built in some flexibility to make the transition as manageable as we can. We appreciate your patience as we work through the details together.

Here's what you need to know:

### **New Vendor: Direct School Uniforms**

We are moving to a new uniform vendor. After some research, it became clear it would be a much more consistent, streamlined shopping experience for our families. Our new online store through Direct School Uniforms is currently being built and should be open for business by the end of May. We'll send a follow-up email with the store link and ordering information as soon as it's live. **Our base uniform is not changing, you do not need to repurchase completely new items.**

In the meantime, the existing TSCS Lands' End store will remain open through July 1. If you need to purchase uniform items before the new store opens, or want to take advantage of sales, you may still do so through Lands' End but please read the grandfathering guidelines below carefully before purchasing anything, as some items are being retired.

### **PE Uniform**

The standard PE uniform is now a gray shirt with white TSCS logo and black shorts or sweatpants with a white TSCS Logo, which will be available through the TSCS Direct School Uniform Store. Middle and Upper School students enrolled in PE are required to have one. These are not available on Land's End, so you will need to wait for the store link to be live to purchase.

### **Upper School Blazers**

The crested blazer is a required part of the Upper School daily uniform. Beginning 2026–2027, families will be responsible for purchasing their student's blazer directly through Direct School Uniforms, where it will be available alongside all other uniform items. This is a change from previous years, when the school managed the purchasing process on your behalf. The annual \$50 blazer fee will no longer be charged to student accounts.

Students who already have a school-issued blazer in good condition and the correct size are all set, no action needed.

For incoming 9th graders and current upper school students who need to replace a lost or damaged blazer: the school has a limited stock of blazers we are happy to sell directly to families at cost. We'll be in touch soon with details about what's available and how to purchase. If our stock doesn't cover your student's needs, blazers will also be available through Direct School Uniforms when the store opens.

Please plan to have a blazer in hand before the first day of school.

**What's Retiring Immediately** The following items will be considered out of uniform beginning Fall 2026–2027 and should not be worn to school:

- TSCS Hoodies or SCC Hoodies (*may still be worn on Spirit Days*)
- Maroon PE shorts
- Navy jumper dress
- Gray trousers, pants, or shorts

**What's Being Phased Out** The following items may still be worn during the 2026-2027 school year but should not be repurchased. They will be out of uniform beginning Fall 2027–2028:

- Maroon or Red outerwear (*may still be worn on Spirit Days*)
- Red v-neck sweater vest

**What You Can Keep** The following items may continue to be worn as part of the standard uniform until they are outgrown or worn out. When it's time to replace them, purchase from Direct School Uniforms:

- Any Lands' End skirt, jumper, or skort in the school plaid (*must meet current length policy*)
- Lands' End French blue button-down shirts, short or long sleeve
- Any Lands' End navy or charcoal gray sweater or fleece jacket. (*The charcoal gray fleece jacket will remain in uniform, but will only be available in navy through our new supplier. They might bring charcoal back, in which case we will add it back to the store*)
- Any brand polo in white, navy, or light blue with an embroidered school crest (*crest must be in place on all polos in all age divisions by January 2027. Logos are NOT*

*required for Early Childhood shirts. Sand Oak's embroidery service will remain available through December 2026 – you must physically drop off the items you would like embroidered, and they have our logo on file)*
