GENERAL INFORMATION

Textbooks and School Property

Class Participation/Attendance

Class participation is an integral part of a student's ability to gain credit in summer school. Class participation will be weighted heavily into grading during Summer Academy. **A student is able to miss two (2) classes.** After that, the student will be removed from the summer program, regardless of the reason. **There will be no exceptions to this rule.** A drop notice will be sent to that student's school counselor as well. Appointments, vacations, or camps are not excused absences.
