In compliance with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), Westerville City Schools is providing written annual Notification of the availability of our Asbestos Management Plan.

Per Federal regulations, Westerville City Schools had all buildings inspected for asbestos-containing materials and developed a Management Plan in December of 1988. ### The following asbestos-related activities occurred in 2025:

1. Spring 2025 - AHERA 3-Year Reinspection.
2. Fall 2025 - AHERA 6-Month Asbestos Surveillance Inspection.
3. Various dates - Asbestos repairs and removal at various sites as necessary to complete renovation work.
4. Review and update of Asbestos Management Plan.
5. Issuance of Annual Asbestos Management Plan Notification.

### The following asbestos-related activities are planned for 2026:

1. Spring 2026 - AHERA 6-Month Asbestos Surveillance Inspection.
2. Fall 2026 - AHERA 6-Month Asbestos Surveillance Inspection.
3. Various dates - Asbestos repair if damaged materials are found and removal at various sites as necessary to complete renovation work.
4. Review and update of Asbestos Management Plan.
5. Issuance of Annual Asbestos Management Plan Notification.
