HOW TO SUBMIT A RECIPE

3. ABBREVIATE MEASUREMENTS IN THE INGREDIENTS LIST.
4. USE INGREDIENT NAMES IN THE DIRECTIONS, E.G., USE "COMBINE FLOUR AND SUGAR", RATHER THAN "COMBINE FIRST TWO INGREDIENTS". "COMBINE ALL" IS SUITABLE.
5. RECIPE NOTES: PLEASE INCLUDE YOUR NAME, CITY, TOWNSHIP OR VILLAGE. INCLUDE IF YOU ARE A COMMUNITY MEMBER OR BUSINESS OWNER, ALONG WITH BUSINESS NAME. FOR SCHOOL STAFF, INCLUDE YOUR CLASSROOM GRADE, BUILDING, OR POSITION. WE ENCOURAGE EVERYONE TO INCLUDE A BRIEF NOTE ABOUT THE RECIPE'S STORY, MEANING, OR FAMILY TRADITION. LIMITED TO 50 CHARACTERS.
6. CHOOSE A RECIPE CATEGORY, E.G., DRINK, APPETIZER, LUNCH, DINNER, DESSERT, ETC.
