## The Gist with Fr. Jeremy



### St. Paul on Unity vs. Disunity

Recently, I have been reading through St. Paul's first letter to the Corinthians. I picked it as an Eastertime meditation because this letter tells us a lot about what the early Church was like, and during Eastertime, I feel connected to the early Church. In the early Church, the memory of Christ's Resurrection was fresh and alive, and it pumped energy into their faith like a beating heart. Looking back at that time is a great way to pray during the season of Easter.

One of the main themes in this letter is unity. Unity vs. disunity is a popular theme right now, and so I thought it would be good to share a few insights from St. Paul. These come primarily from 1 Corinthians 1-4, which is where Paul speaks about this topic in that letter.

- 1) **Unity is Not a Matter of Secondary Concern:** Paul calls out the Corinthians for a lot of different things in this letter, including elitism, liturgical anomalies, and sexual immorality, but the first thing he focuses on is unity. Even amidst so many other problems, unity was the first thing on Paul's mind, and he spent the most space on it in the letter.
- 2) **Disunity Prevents Christian Maturity:** Paul says that he was unable to feed the Corinthians with "solid food" but only with "milk" because as long as there is "jealousy and quarrelling" among them, they are not ready to advance beyond spiritual infancy.
- 3) **Disunity Interferes with the Work of God:** St. Paul compares the Church in Corinth to "God's building" and "God's field." We often think about the work that God does in our lives as individuals, but God is also at work at the level of the whole local Church to shape the shared life of faith. When we create obstacles to a shared life of faith, we interfere with God's plans.
- 4) **Building Up Unity is Part of Our Personal Sanctification:** In Chapter 3, Paul speaks about how in "God's building" there are builders, and each builder's work will be tested by God. Paul says that bad work will be burned up and "the builder will be saved, but only as through fire." This is a famous proof-text for the Catholic teaching on Purgatory. Namely, that our individual impurities will be purified by God after death so that we can be saved. This is a valid meaning to pull from the verse, but we should note that the original meaning of Paul is less about being purified from individual vices, and more about being purified for failure to contribute to the building up of the Church.
- 5) **A Sense of Being "Real Catholics" Creates Disunity:** Paul says that the disunity in the Corinthian Church comes from some saying that they "belong to Paul" while others say, "I belong to Apollos. Paul even criticizes those who say, "I belong to Christ." We might wonder what is wrong with this last formulation, but the issue is that there is an implicit, "...and others don't belong to Christ." We should be extremely wary when we start to feel like, "This group that I am part of are the 'real Catholics'." We may be aware of deficiencies in the faith of others, but that should not cause us to refuse to identify with them, or to feel superior.
- 6) **Desiring Unity Doesn't Mean That Anything Goes:** Later on in First Corinthians, Paul says that the sin of a fellow Christian can require correction. These situations require discernment and wisdom, but the point is that desiring unity does not mean we never hold people accountable. However, they must be held accountable precisely as a brother or sister. This means more than just words. One person who holds another accountable must sincerely desire fellowship with that person. When this desire is present, it changes the way the conversation goes. This is why striving for bonds of fellowship with our fellow Christians makes us more capable of fraternal correction, not less.

- 7) **Disunity Comes When We Forget the Cross:** Paul rebukes the Corinthians for thinking that they have left the cross behind, and have already, "begun to reign." Building up community is hard. We have to talk and listen to people we disagree with; we have to overcome our own selfish proclivities; we have to bear the faults of others patiently; and we have to set aside other things we might prefer to do instead. If we forget that the Christian life is characterized by the cross, and this kind of sacrifice is necessary for our sanctification, we will not be willing to do it.

There are many more things I could say, but I would note two ways that St. Paul's words on unity are different than the popular conversation. In the popular conversation, the focus is on unity and disunity at the highest levels, i.e. "Our country is so divided right now." St. Paul's focus is on the local level, literally in the local Church. Secondly, the popular conversation talks about why disunity is bad, but it doesn't really offer a compelling vision of what we need unity for. For St. Paul, building up unity in the Church is how we cooperate with Christ's grace. St. Paul did not have an individualistic view of how we become saints. He didn't see sainthood as praying a lot in private. He saw it more as dying to ourselves to build up the Body of Christ in very literal and concrete ways in our local Church.
