Host a ONE Future Grade Level or Shared Interest Information Session

About These Events

In Support of our Capital Campaign, we are inviting families to volunteer as hosts for small, informal gatherings in their homes. These one-hour sessions bring together families by grade level or shared interests to learn more about the campaign, ask questions, and understand how collective participation helps us reach our fundraising goal.

These gatherings are an important way to:

- Build community and strengthen connections among families
- Share the vision for the school's future
- Help families understand how they can be part of building the school they want for their children

What Does a Host Do?

As a host, you are opening your home and helping create a welcoming, comfortable environment for conversation.

Hosts are asked to:

- Open their home for a one-hour session
- Provide light refreshments (coffee, juice, muffins, etc. — nothing elaborate)
- Let us know how many guests your space can comfortably accommodate
- Welcome guests as they arrive

Speaking is entirely optional — hosts are not required to speak if they are uncomfortable; however, if you are willing, you may:

- Briefly welcome the group or introduce the Head of School
- Share a few words about why you love the school or why you chose to host

Please note that hosting is a completely voluntary effort, and hosts are not compensated or reimbursed for expenses.

What Will the School Do?

The school will fully support the event and manage all programmatic and logistical details beyond hosting.

The school will:

- Handle invitations, RSVPs, and attendee tracking
- Provide RSVP forms and guest lists
- Coordinate scheduling and guest communication
- Provide the programming and presentation

At each event, one or more of the following will attend and lead the session:

- Head of School
- A member of the Advancement Team
- Capital Campaign volunteer

They will:

- Share information about the Capital Campaign
- Answer questions
- Guide the conversation and discussion
