Board Policy Board Policy (BP) 5142.04 - Bicycles and E-Bikes was created to strengthen student safety and establish clear expectations for bike, E-bike, and E-moto transportation to and from school.



ELEMENTARY SCHOOL (GRADES TK-6)

- ✓ Students in elementary school are strictly prohibited from possessing or operating E-bikes, E-motos, and other devices, as listed in the definitions of BP 5142.04, on school property, including the periphery of campus, at all times.
- ✓ Students are encouraged to ride bicycles and are required to participate in a bike safety training, along with other requirements outlined in BP 5142.04.



MIDDLE/INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL (GRADES 7-8)

- ✓ Students in middle/intermediate school are strictly prohibited from possessing or operating E-bikes, E-motos, and other devices, as listed in the definitions of BP 5142.04, on school property, including the periphery of campus, at all times.
- ✓ Students are encouraged to ride bicycles and are required to participate in a bike safety training, along with other requirements outlined in BP 5142.04.



HIGH SCHOOL (GRADES 9-12)

- ✓ Students in grades 9-12 may possess an E-bike on campus.
- ✓ E-motos and other devices, as listed in the definitions of BP 5142.04, are strictly prohibited on any district property.
- ✓ Students are required to participate in an E-bike/bicycle safety training program, along with other requirements outlined in BP 5142.04.
