CAMP FIRE EL TESORO DE LA VIDA

Camp Fire El Tesoro de la Vida is a overnight summer camp uniquely designed to support children who have experienced the death of a loved one.



Most adults have experienced loss and grief, but children do not always possess the necessary skills to cope with their loss effectively. El Tesoro de la Vida helps kids learn these skills alongside their peers.

The co-ed program consists of 90% traditional camping activities and 10% activities structured to help children through the natural grieving process. Licensed Professional Counselors (LPCs) lead small group sessions and are on-site the whole week to provide counseling and support.

Camp El Tesoro is a 223-acre camp in Granbury, Texas. Campers live in modern cabins with two trained adult volunteers who are educated in the grieving process.

Camp Fire ensures any child who is grieving has access to camp through a scholarship program supported by the generosity of many individuals, foundations and organizations in the community. Be a donor at CampFireFW.org/donate

Due to the uniqueness of Camp Fire El Tesoro de la Vida each application is reviewed by a licensed professional counselor. It takes at least two weeks to process most applications. LPCs will begin making calls for family interviews in May. Acceptance will be based upon the LPC's interview and recommendation.

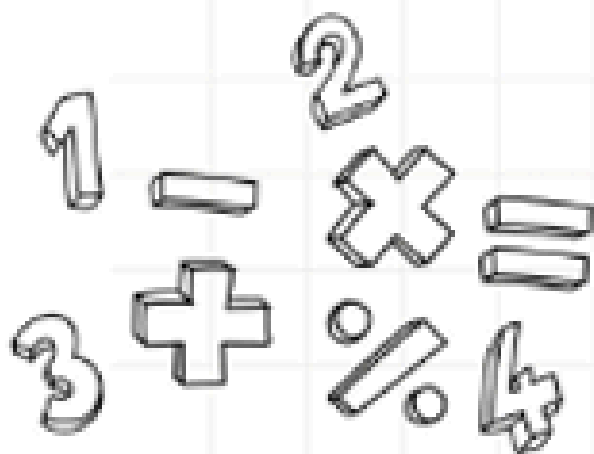

IMPORTANT!



We have seen an increase in requests from students and parents asking administration to review security camera footage to locate lost items.

Please understand that our cameras are in place to support the safety and security of our campus and are not used to track misplaced belongings.

With approximately 1,000 students, reviewing footage is reserved for safety-related concerns. We strongly encourage families to be mindful of items brought to school, particularly expensive or irreplaceable belongings, as teenagers may misplace them during the school day.

Reminder: Beginning January 2026,

all HEB ISD bus riders should have and use a SMART Tag each time they ride.

While all students are expected to use their SMART Tag, this requirement will be actively enforced for secondary students (grades 7–12).

Students who do not present a valid SMART Tag may be denied bus service, including for athletics, band, and CTE shuttles.
