Below are the testing dates for each subject:

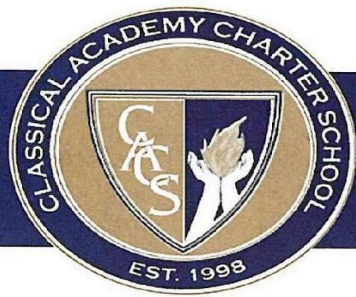
- **NJSLA Math:** Week of **May 4th, 2026**

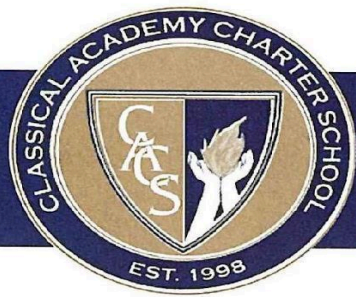
