Goal 1: EMS SIC will work to improve the overall academic achievement in reading and math.

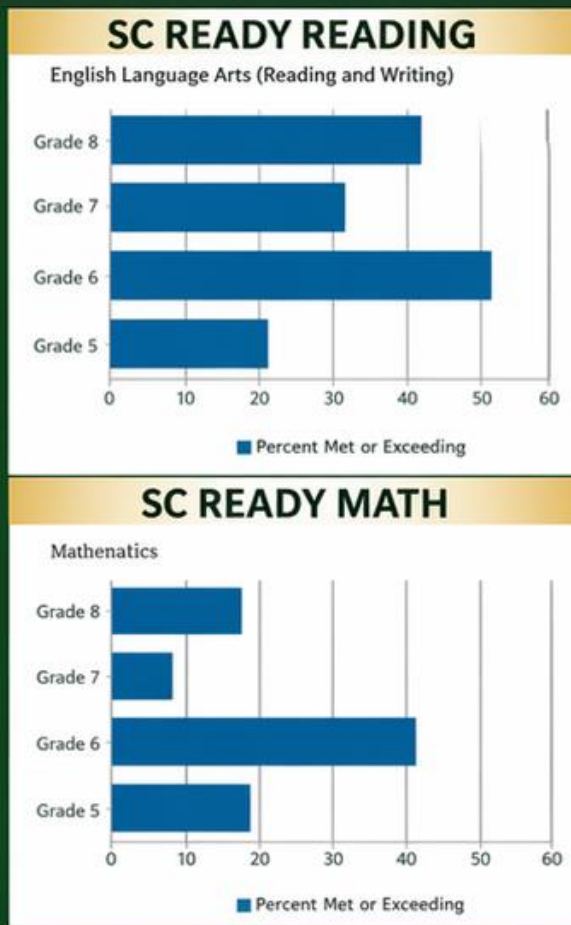
Goal 2: EMS SIC will work to improve the overall school climate.

# TEST DATA



SC READY data from 2025 revealed that only 33.6% of students were meeting/exceeding expectations in reading and only 21.4% of students were meeting/exceeding state expectations in math. This is significantly below the 2030 state requirement of at least 75% of students being at or above grade level. The SIC reviewed and gave input on SRP Goals.
