### READING

We are beginning a unit focusing on Greek and Latin root words, prefixes, and suffixes. The text set we are navigating this month is the theme of Grit and Perseverance. We will end the month by reading the novel Coraline.

### MATH

We will now move into a unit where we combine decimals and fractions. Students will learn how to multiply and divide fractions as well as convert those fractions to decimals. During Guided Math time, we will focus on Polygons. Students will be able to give two-three attributes for any given polygon. Anchor charts will contain information we are learning.

### SCIENCE

Our Water Cycle and Weather unit is coming to a close, and we will be testing on this material next week. Our final unit we will dive into is Forces & Motion unit. We'll be exploring how objects move and the invisible forces that act upon them. It's going to be a "fast-moving" month! Keep studying that vocab!

### SOCIAL STUDIES

Our study of the American Revolution continues! Students are exploring the influential people of the colonies and the courage it took to fight for freedom. By using simulations and interactive projects, we are bringing history to life and helping students understand the profound shift from colonial rule to independence.

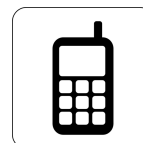
