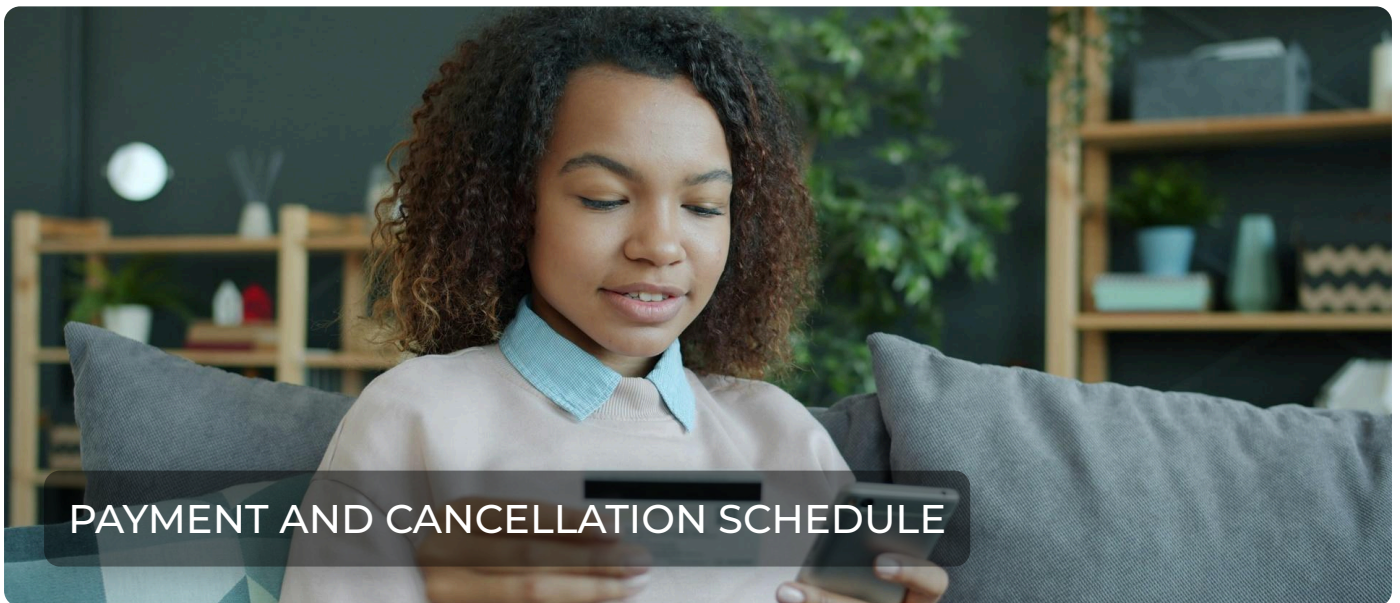
Activities Included
