FAQS

Is there transportation available?

Yes, transportation services serve La Paloma.

How many credits are required?

165. 155 of those are core classes, 10 are electives.

How are credits earned?

15 productive days in class=1 credit, this is not a “seat time” school. Students must be active learners in the classroom to earn credits.

How can students earn more credits?

Students can earn additional productive days through office hours for each teacher which are held 3x a week from 2:45-3:20. There is also the opportunity for Progress Work when students can maintain 80% attendance or above.

Is the coursework packet-based?

No. We are a daily school of instruction.

Is the diploma a high school diploma?

Yes.

Is there a graduation ceremony?

Yes.

Can graduates attend college?

Yes, however, students cannot go straight to a four-year after graduating, they must go to a junior college to start.

Can a student transfer back to their comprehensive site?

Yes, they can, but usually students do not return to their comprehensive site.

What is La Paloma High School

LaP is a fully accredited Continuation High School within LUHSD. It is an Alternative Education school serving up to 210 students.

Who is eligible?

Credit deficient students that are 16 and older. *Students with an IEP must go through their case manager first to apply.

Why do families choose LaP?

Smaller, flexible setting, personalized academic support, graduation is obtainable for their student, no daily homework.

What does a typical day look like?

Students attend in-person classes from 8:30-2:45 for a 7 period day, 45 minute periods.

How do students transfer?

Transfers are reviewed twice monthly for intake.

Any other enrollment requirements?
