

ATTENTION PARENTS OF UPCOMING 11TH AND 12TH GRADE STUDENTS

The **MOVE ON WHEN READY (MOWR) Act** allows qualified juniors and seniors to enroll fulltime in a participating college or university and earn credit for high school graduation, without being enrolled or attending high school.

Some important points to keep in mind. (See link below for all requirements and information)

- Students must at least have a GPA of 3.25
- Students would not be able to participate in any high school activities, including extracurricular
- Families will be responsible for all transportation to the college or university
- Families are responsible for any tuition, fees, or textbook costs that exceed state MOWR funding.
