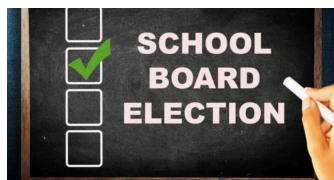

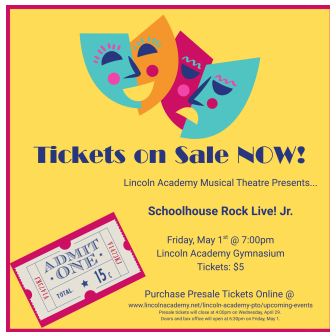


Board of Directors Elections
