How Budget Decisions Have Made an Impact

- Focused on student support services
- Strengthened instructional leadership
- Expanded staffing and programming
- Improved facilities and learning environments



Staffing Enhancements (Building Level)



- Added **Social Worker** to support student well-being
- Created **two special classes** to meet diverse needs
- Increased number of **ICT (Integrated Co-Teaching) sections**
- **Doubled Speech & Language services**, including bilingual support
- Expanded **OT and PT services**
- Increased **aide staffing** for student support
- Added **security greeter** to enhance safety and community presence

Staffing Enhancements (District Level)



- Director of Literacy
- Supervisor of Instruction
- Literacy Coach
- Director of STEM
- Director of Multilingual Programs
- Director of Performing Arts
- Director of Diversity, Equity Inclusion, and Belonging

Impact:

- Increased supervision and coaching
- More targeted professional development
- Stronger instructional practices → improved student outcomes

Instructional Model Shift → Departmentalization

- Allows teachers to specialize in content areas
- Increases instructional depth and expertise
- Provides students with more targeted, high-quality instruction
- STEM classes for grades K-5

Student Achievement → ELA Growth

ELA Proficiency

- 2023: 83% proficiency
- 2025: 89% proficiency

What This Means:

- Decreased Level 1 from 15% to 8%
- Significant academic growth
- Stronger literacy outcomes across grades
- Positive impact of curriculum and instructional investments



Performance on New York State ELA Assessments



Student Achievement → Math Growth

MATH Proficiency

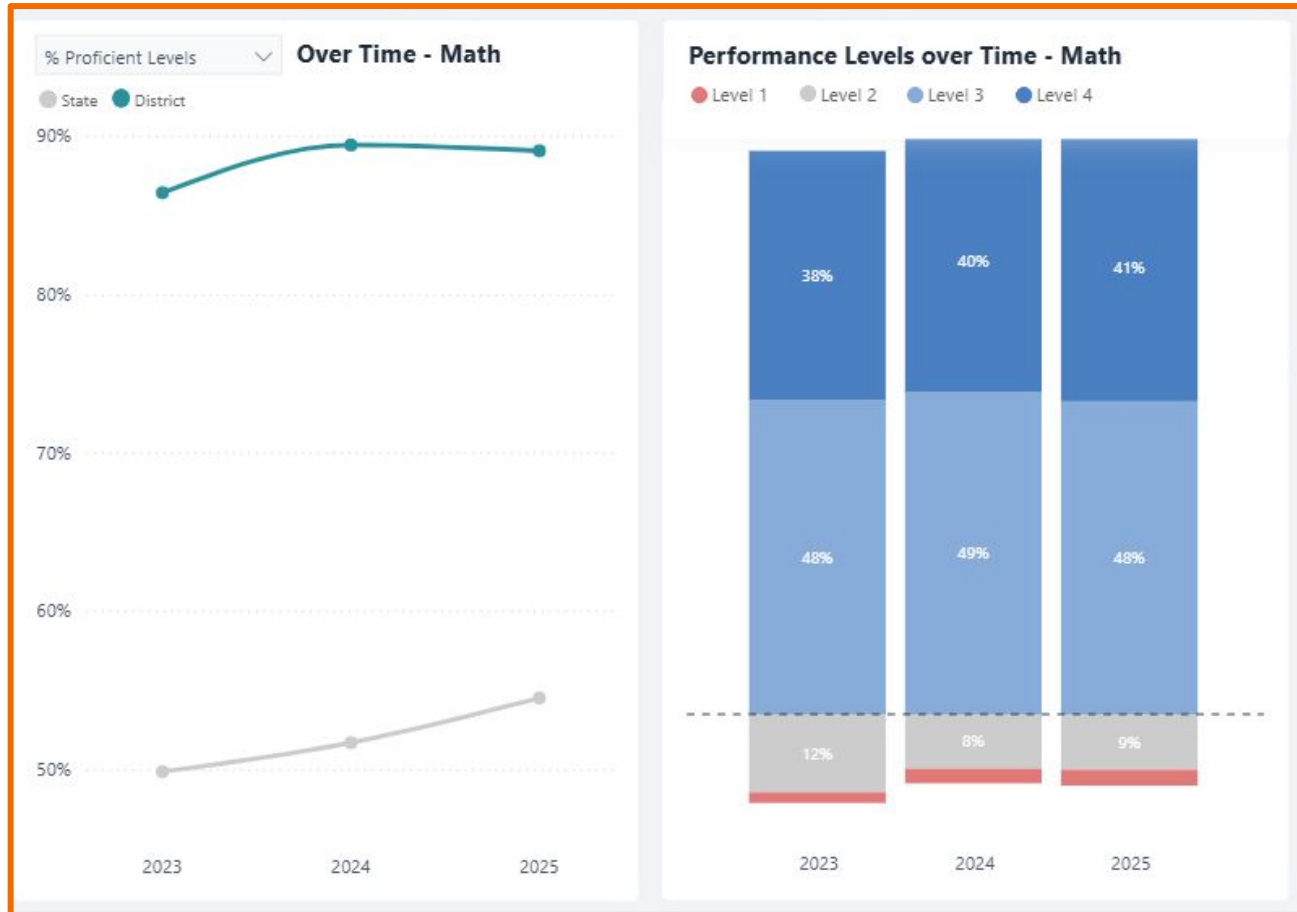
- 2023: 86% proficiency
- 2025: 89% proficiency

What This Means:

- Decreased Level 1 from 12% to 9%
- Stronger outcomes across grades
- Positive impact of curriculum and instructional investments
- Kids see themselves as mathmenticians!



Performance on New York State Math Assessments



Student Achievement → Science Growth

SCIENCE Proficiency (Grade 5 ONLY)

- 2023: 72% proficiency
- 2025: 82% proficiency

What This Means:

- Decreased Level 1 from 28% to 15%
- Stronger science outcomes due to vertical alignment
- Positive impact of curriculum and instructional investments



Performance on New York State SCIENCE Assessments



Student Behaviors → Positive Change

Number of Documented Incidents requiring Admin Intervention

- 2023: 33 Incidents
- 2025: 22 Incidents

What This Means:

- Grade-level Community Meetings and SEL practices support emotional regulation and conflict resolution
- Integration of Distric and school Sequity practices and tools

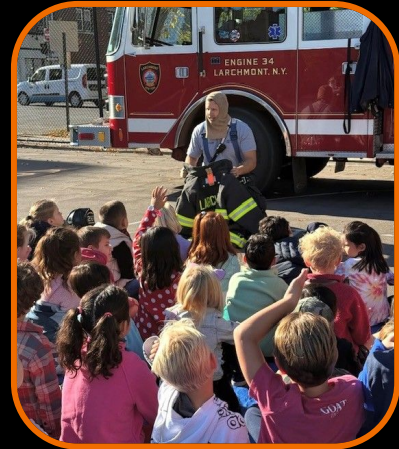

- Upgrades to **cafeteria, library, and art room**
- Creation of **multi-media room for animation and digital learning**
- Installation of an **elevator** for accessibility

 - 173 students accessing lunchclubs (chess & improv)
 - 26% access
 - Doubled participation
