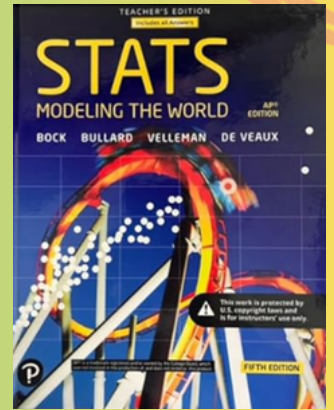


# STATISTICS

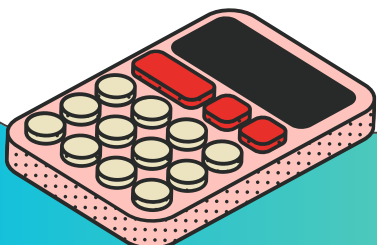
