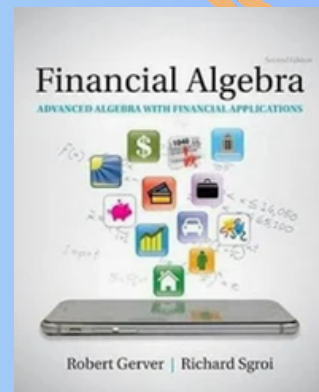


FINANCIAL ALGEBRA
