Parking Permit Information – Parking permits are \$50 and must be purchased each school year. Two payment options: Cash or online payments using **School Cash Online**. Permits may be purchased in the Main Office (Level 2). Completed vehicle information cards must be signed by the student and parent/guardian. **CTE student drivers do not have to purchase an additional Weaver parking permit**; however, they must display the parking permit from their home school AND complete the vehicle information card. If you choose to use **School Cash Online** for payment, print and submit your receipt of payment to the Main Office.

Students who complete Driver Education behind-the-wheel training must have a **Driving Eligibility Certificate (DEC)** from **Weaver Academy** to present to the **N.C. Department of Motor Vehicles** when applying for a **Learner's Permit**. The **DEC** is valid for **30 days** and requires a parent signature. Call **Mrs. Jones** in the **Counseling Office** for an appointment to get the **Driving Eligibility Certificate**.
