

Your child participated in the ILEARN assessments for their grade level (grades 3-8) this spring.

What does this mean for you?

ZCS has started to receive preliminary student scores and will review all results. We do know, and have communicated, the skills your child mastered and demonstrated this school year through our standards-based report card. We are looking forward to working with your child in the coming year to enhance and continue making growth in all areas of their academic program. Final ILEARN scores for science will be available in the parent portal July 1, 2026. Final ILEARN scores for English/language arts, math, and social studies are anticipated in September 2026.

So, why are we sharing this information?

In accordance with Indiana Code 20-32-5.1-12(d), notification must be sent to parents/guardians to provide an opportunity to review and request a rescore for eligible open-ended item(s) only. ZCS will further analyze any students with scores that, upon review, might result in a higher categorical score for consideration.

Important Information about the ILEARN Rescore Request Process:

- Parents or guardians who wish to view students' response images for selected IDOE items and scoring rubrics (at this time, no one can view a student's entire test) must make an appointment between May 11th – June 5th at your child's school.
- It is important to know that a rescore request could result in an increased or decreased score.
- Your building administrator will submit any rescore request(s) on your behalf in the online platform during this appointment.
- Once a rescore has been submitted, it cannot be changed or reversed.

ZCS wants to focus on the learning that took place this school year and your child's needs for the upcoming year. We do this by using a variety of assessments such as NWEA, CogAT, classroom/course assessments, standards-based report cards, and teacher observations and dialogue with your child. We will review the ILEARN proficiency scores we receive, but we will continue to use all data to gain a full picture of your child, so we can focus on individual student growth.
