



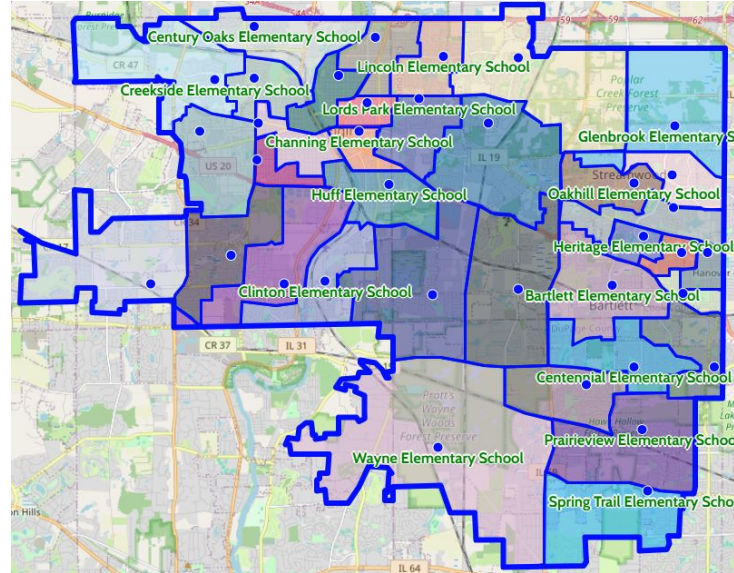

Enrollment and Registration Snapshot



- **30,169 students are enrolled for next school year.**
- **33% of K-12 students are registered (10,097 out of known 30,169).**
- **77% of Kindergarteners registered (927 out of known 1,207).**



Transportation Routing Update



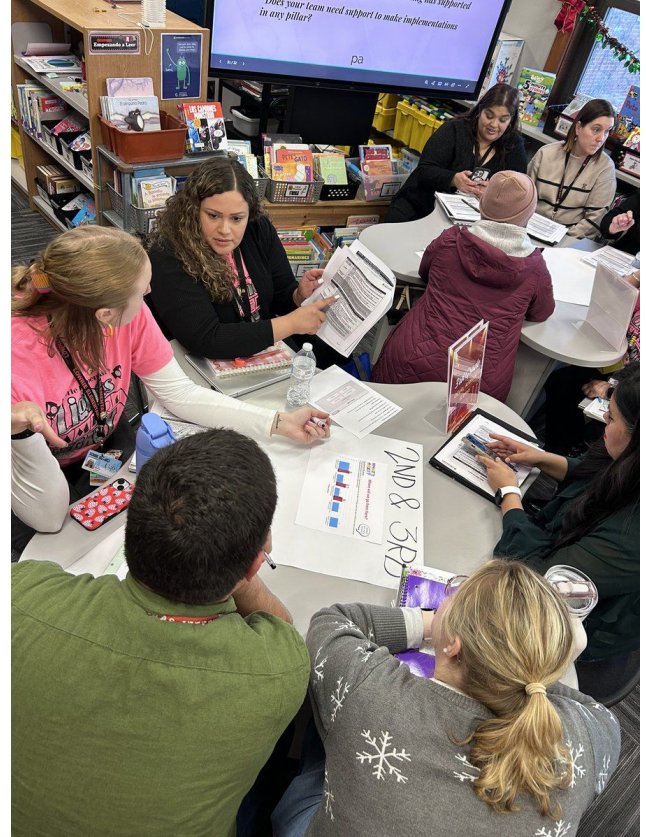
- Hazards are being reviewed and routes are being adjusted.
- Families who no longer qualify for transportation will be receiving communication this week.
- Qualifying families will be able to access transportation route information in Infinite Campus by August 15, 2026.



ETA Staffing Update



- **Our internal transfer reassignment process has been completed.**
- **Positions have been posted to external candidates as of today.**
- **We have approximately 350 teacher vacancies remaining for the 2026-2027 school year.**
 - ▶ About 180 teachers affected by the Reduction in Force are eligible to apply for and be rehired into open positions.
