She then facilitated a reflective activity by asking participants to respond to the following prompts:

Ms. Beavers emphasized that these are valuable questions to support mental health for both students and staff. Participants were encouraged to share their responses aloud.

Mr. Glynn introduced **Ms. Miles and Ms. Muñoz**, Parent and Family Engagement Specialists.

Key points:

- They serve as a **connection between schools, students, and families**
- Partnered with **Elementary ACE** and hosted a **vendor fair**
- Noted **low attendance at workshops**
  - Parent feedback indicated **timing** as the main issue
  - Plans to shift workshops to more convenient afternoon times

Upcoming focus:

- **STAAR Parent Workshops** to help families support students at home
- Ms. Muñoz shared that STAAR can be especially challenging for **bilingual students**, based on personal experience

### Stronger Connections Grant (SCG)

Ms. Jackson provided updates:

- **Hygiene Hubs** available (contact via email/phone for requests)
- Partnership with **Baylor Counseling** to provide **free counseling sessions for staff** (coming soon)
- **High School Food Pantry** served approximately **500 students in one day**
- Invitation to visit the **Junior High Ron Clark Academy model**
