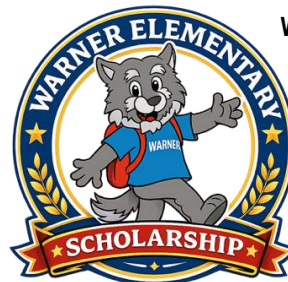

Families can see below when registration opens for each program, including K-12, Qualified Pre-K and Pre-K tuition-based options.

- New students (grades K-12) opens **March 16**.
- Qualified Pre-K opens **March 16**.
- Tuition-based Pre-K (employees only) opens **March 16**.
- Tuition-Based Pre-K (Community & Out-of-District Families) opens **April 13**

For the 2026-2027 school year, Warner will continue to follow our cluster schools, Rennell, Sampson and Wells and will **NOT** be allowing rolling backpacks.

For the safety of students, rolling backpacks are not recommended since all backpacks must be carried by the student during arrival, dismissal, and throughout the school building. Rolling backpacks tend to be heavier for the students to carry and they also are bulkier so they are difficult to store in the classroom cabinets. For our bus riders, all backpacks need to be on their backs to enter/exit the bus and in the aisle as well. We recommend a lighter backpack, especially for our littlest Warner Wolves.

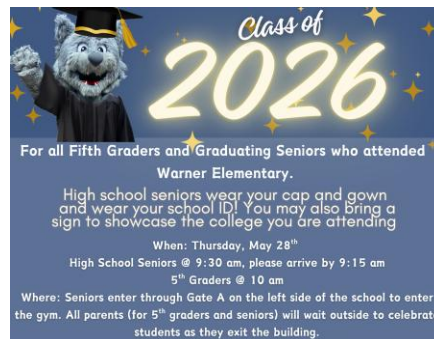
