The Discovery Orchestra provides transformative listening encounters for people from all backgrounds, from novices to knowledgeable classical music lovers. In short, we teach the listening skills that help people really connect with classical music.

For over 20 years, millions of viewers have experienced the joys of classical music listening through our award-winning productions distributed by American Public Television: Bach to the Future, Discover Beethoven's 5th, Discover Vivaldi's Four Seasons, Fall in Love with Music 8-part series, Discover The Firebird, and Discover Saint-Saëns' "Organ" Symphony. Our television shows are available on PBS Passport, Amazon Prime Video, and are streamed to libraries and classrooms nationally by Films Media Group. About our Founder and Artistic Director

George Marriner Maull, a three-time Emmy® nominated public television personality, has helped millions nationwide to heighten their classical music listening pleasure through his Discovery Concerts® for American Public Television. His signature course, Fall in Love with Music, originally recorded as an 8-part public television series, can be streamed on Amazon Prime. His public radio show Inside Music is broadcast on the 2nd and 4th Saturdays each month at 7:30 PM EST on WWFM—The Classical Network throughout New Jersey and can be streamed worldwide at wwfm.org.

Maestro Maull's New Jersey musical affiliations began when he was appointed Assistant Conductor of the New Jersey Symphony Orchestra for the 1979-80 season and founding Music Director of the New Jersey Youth Symphony that same season. He led the NJYS for eighteen years until 1997, including three performances at Carnegie Hall and four European tours. His work as an educator has been enhanced by his conducting career, including leading performances at Carnegie Hall and Lincoln Center, as well as in England, The Netherlands, Belgium, Romania, Hungary, and Poland. Among the posts he has held in the past: Assistant Conductor of the New Jersey Symphony Orchestra, Music Director and Conductor of the Louisville Ballet, the New Jersey Youth Symphony, and the Philharmonic Orchestra of New Jersey. His audio recordings conducting the Polish National Radio Symphony are on the Naxos label.

The University of Louisville honored Maestro Maull in 1994 as a Distinguished Alumnus and named him a 2018 Alumni Fellow. His biography has been listed in Who's Who in America each year since 1994, and in 2018 the Marquis Who's Who Publications Board honored him with an Albert Nelson Marquis Lifetime Achievement Award.
