Discovery Middle School's five periods of Spanish classes will meet in the school's Family and Consumer Sciences room on Thursday as they take their tastebuds on an international adventure in celebration of Cinco de Mayo.

At the Cinco de Mayo Fiesta, students will explore Mexican cuisine as they celebrate the Mexico's victory over France at the Battle of Puebla in 1862. The students will spend the first 20 minutes of their class time prepping and cooking their Mexican dishes and the rest enjoying each other's food and celebrating the holiday. They will make seven different Hispanic dishes at seven different stations. Celebrations will be held during periods 1, 3, 4, 6, and 7.

Dishes created may vary, but could include guacamole, enchiladas, tres leches cake, Ecuadorian cheese bread, fried plantains, quesadillas, chicken tacos, salsa, and chicken tortilla soup.

Parent volunteers will be on-hand during the fiesta to help guide students through preparing their unique recipes. Parents were also asked to help donate ingredients for the dishes.
