**Measure "O"**

**Applicant Packet for Vacancy**

The Tracy Unified School District Board of Education needs to fill a vacancy on the Citizen's Bond Oversight Committee. This committee reviews expenditures from construction activity associated with Measure "O", which was approved by District voters on November 5, 2025. The Committee is responsible for ensuring that bond revenues are used only as voters intended and for informing the public of bond expenditures. The Board invites all interested community members to apply to fill this vacancy on the Bond Oversight Committee.

**Who is on the Committee?**

The Bond Oversight Committee must have at least seven members, in addition to two members of the community at large. This application is to fill a vacancy in the following category:

- **One member who is active in a business organization representing the business community located within the school district.**

This position may not include any employee or official of the school district or any vendor, contractor, or consultant of the school district. Members must be at least 18 years old, and preference will be given to members who live within the geographic boundary of the District.

**What does the Committee do?**

The committee is responsible for making at least one annual report to the Board of Education and the community about bond expenditures by preparing an annual written report containing its findings which will be described at the Board's public meeting, and posted on the District's web site, along with Committee agendas and meeting minutes.

**How often does the Committee meet?**

The Committee is required to meet at least one time per year. Specific meeting dates are determined by the Committee in collaboration with the District.

**How will candidate to fill the vacancy be selected?**

The Board of Education will select the candidate taking into account the applicant's professional and/or practical experience, the applicant's recognition in or contribution to his/her community, the diversity of experience on the Committee as a whole, and representation on the Committee from various communities within the District.

**What else should the applicant know?**

Under the provisions of Education Code Section 35233, a member of the Committee may not have any financial interests in any contracts made with the District during the member's term. Committee members may also be subject to the Political Reform Act of 1974 and its Conflict of Interest Provision.

All committee proceedings are open to the public and will be subject to the Brown Act. All documents and reports received or published by the Committee will be a matter of public record, and will be made available on the District's web site.

The Board of Education will provide the Committee with administrative support and sufficient resources to publicize the committee reports.
