### The Role

ASHK is seeking a well-qualified, patient, and highly motivated Parent-funded Educational Assistant (PFEA) to provide dedicated 1:1 support for an elementary student with moderate learning needs.

The successful candidate will work under the guidance of the Head of Elementary Learning Support, Classroom Teacher(s) and the Head of Counselling to facilitate the student's access to the curriculum, develop social-emotional resilience, and thrive within our inclusive community. This role is specifically designed for a professional who can contribute to and implement individualized strategies to bridge learning gaps and foster independence.

### Responsibilities

#### Learning & Student Support

- Provide dedicated 1:1 support for the assigned student inside and outside the classroom to facilitate full participation in school life.
- Implement ABA-informed (Applied Behavior Analysis) practices and strategies to support the student's behavioral and learning goals.
- Assist in the implementation and tracking of Individual Education Plans (IEPs), monitoring progress and suggesting adjustments based on data and observation.
- Foster the student's social development by facilitating positive interactions with peers and supporting the development of self-regulation skills.
- Under the guidance of the Head of Learning Support and the Head of Counselling, collaborate with external professionals (Speech Therapists, Occupational Therapists, etc.) to integrate therapeutic goals into the school day.
- Prepare and adapt learning resources and visual supports tailored to the student's specific needs.
- Additional duties as determined and required by the ESST

#### Communication & Administration

- Maintain detailed and accurate records of student progress, behavioral data, and interventions using school digital platforms.
- Provide regular, professional updates to the Student Support team regarding daily progress and milestones.
- Assist in maintaining documentation for parent meetings and annual reviews
- Participate in Individual Educational Plan (IEP) meeting under the direction of the ESST as needed

### Standards & Community

- Model ASHK's guiding principles of respect, compassion, and integrity.
- Maintain high standards of professional conduct, including punctuality, dress, and confidentiality.
- Attend relevant team meetings and engage in professional development related to inclusive education.
- Ensure a safe learning environment by complying with all school health, safety, and child safeguarding policies.

### **Requirements**

- **Experience:** Proven experience supporting students with additional support needs (ASN), on the Autism Spectrum (ASD) and/or those with moderate learning difficulties in an educational setting.
- **Expertise:** Direct experience or training in ABA-informed practices is highly desirable.
- **Qualifications:** A relevant degree or diploma in Education, Special Education, Psychology, or a related field.
- **Mindset:** A patient, empathetic, and resilient approach to student support, with a commitment to the ASHK vision of nurturing lifelong learners.
- **Communication:** Excellent English communication skills (written and oral) to collaborate effectively with teachers, specialists, and parents and support students who may have expressive/receptive language needs.
- **Eligibility:** Must possess a valid employment visa or have the right to work in Hong Kong.
