## **Approval of February Meeting Minutes:**

Abigail Carrasco states that since there was not a quorum present today; no voting would be taking place in this meeting.

## **Presentation:**

Hannah Kidd from the Crisis Center presented the updated curriculum proposed to be implemented in the 26/27 school year.

- The Crisis Center provides services for adult and minor victims of domestic violence.
- Services are free and confidential.
- Provides prevention education to bring awareness and educate the community about domestic and sexual violence.
- A survey completed revealed that 80% of the respondents learned about dating violence at school and 33% of also learned about dating violence at home.
- Current curriculum consists of 13 presentations that are 30-45 minutes each.
- New curriculum will consist of 4 presentations that are 30-45 minutes each.
  - Healthy Communication
  - Healthy Relationships
  - Technology Safety
  - Teen Dating Violence
- Hannah Kidd opened the floor for questions:
  - Sara Hinshaw asked about the fidelity of decreasing the number of presentations.
    - Hannah Kidd replied that the bid ideas were pulled out of the 13 lessons and put into 4 lessons.
  - Christina Acosta asked which grade levels would receive this education.
    - Hannah Kidd replied that the curriculum is designed for Middle and High School students.

    - Shawn Routh replied that campus counselors coordinate with the Crisis Center and obtain all of the parental consents for students.
